ICEBREAKER

What was Easter like for you growing up?

READ

Luke 19: 28-38

QUESTIONS

- Where is Jesus? Look at a map. How close is He to Jerusalem?
- What task does he give two of His disciples?
- To be obedient, what do those followers need to be ready to do? ([Ready to go, ready to give](#))
- What problems might they have encountered?
- What do you think people expected Jesus to do when He reached Jerusalem? ([look back at verse 11](#))
- How were their expectations different from His?
- What kind of reception do you think Jesus would get if He rode into Houston today – by friends, media, elected officials?

- Discuss Ryan's statement: "Your obedience could be attached to someone else's destiny."
- Do you see God pointing you in a divine direction? If so, in what way? How can you stay ready?
- Thinking about the picture of people laying down their cloaks in front of Jesus in verses 35-36, is there something you need to lay down in order to be obedient to His divine direction?
