READ

QUESTION

- What do you think Jesus wrote in the ground? ([John 8:6-7](#))

Ryan shared three things we should walk away with when encountering the Person of Grace, Jesus:

Don't let other people put shame on you.

Don't put shame on yourself.

We stop sinning because we received grace; not to earn grace.

QUESTIONS

- How can you see yourself as God sees you? ([step away from social media, don't compare yourself to others, know that you are worthy](#))
- How can we move forward from our mistakes? ([forgive yourself, learn from them, find an accountability partner, remember one mistake does not define you](#))
- How can you see others the way God sees them? ([the ground is level at the cross, God's grace is sufficient](#))
