ICEBREAKERS

If you were given one million dollars that you could not keep but had to give away, what would you do with it?

QUESTIONS

- Patrick says, "Following Jesus is about this intimate relationship with God so that
 we are not left to do life the best we can." What gets in your way of following God,
 finding God or loving God?
- Every step forward is progress. What could you do this week to take a step to grow in an area specific to you that would move you closer to following, finding or loving God?

READ

Matthew 6:19-21

QUESTIONS

- What applications or observations do you have from these verses?
- How do you define a treasure?
- How many treasures are we allowed to store on earth? (Jesus says, "do not store up treasures on earth)

- Why do we feel like we have to store up our treasures or possessions here on earth? (security, comfort, feeling good, lack of faith, etc.)
- The place we choose for our treasure says something about ourselves. How can you live in a way that prioritizes treasures for compassionate use to meet others' physical or spiritual needs?

READ

Matthew 6:24 and 1 Timothy 6:10

QUESTIONS

- Why are we so prone to trust money rather than God?
- Why does the love of money battle against being content?
- Why do you think Paul describes money as the root of all kinds of evil? (money is not evil, but the love of money is evil)
- Money is essential to our lives. What attitudes or actions do you think can help us handle money without serving it?

READ

Matthew 6:25 and 6:33

QUESTIONS

- When you worry or grow anxious, how do you respond?
- What did Jesus point to as common areas of worry in Matthew 6:25?
- How have you seen God meet your needs or that of others?
- How can we overcome worry? (Believe you are not alone or on your own, seek God, trust and have peace knowing God wants to provide for you)

As our church takes a big step in faith to expand our mission help us continue in our support of local and global communities alongside our mission partners. Give each of us guidance in how we participate in "I WILL". Thank you for the many ways You've blessed us. In Jesus' Name – Amen.
